



## Jesus Saves ... So Live on Mission

Mark 1:16-20, 2:13-17, 3:13-21

1. Background: Near the beginning of Jesus' ministry, He calls 12 men to work with Him and learn from Him.  
Icebreaker: If you were starting a religious movement, what kind of people would you invite to join you?
  
2. Read the Mark passages again and think back over Sunday's sermon.
  - What points of the sermon/Scriptures resonated with you?
  - What questions came to mind?
  - How were you challenged?
  
3. Personal reflection questions:
  - What are some ministries you have served in (through the church or other Christian organizations)?
  - Has your service been motivated by God's love for you?
  - Do you sometimes feel inadequate for such ministry? If so, what can you do about it?
  
4. Understanding the Scriptures
  - What was Jesus' call to the fisherman? (Mark 1) What was their response?
  - What was His call to Levi? (Mark 2) What was his response? What kind of people were Levi (Matthew) and his friends? Since eating with people implied accepting them, how does Jesus justify eating with them?
  - Did Jesus' apostles seem like a promising group to start a movement with? Did God use them?
  
5. Addressing parallel Scriptures
  - I John 4:19 - Who are we to love? Why are we to love?
  - Acts 10:38 - What did Jesus do in His ministry?
