

Life Group & Personal Bible Study

This guide, based on Sunday's sermon, provides additional study and reflection for both Life Group discussion and personal enrichment. It is not meant to serve as a full Bible study curriculum, exhaustive commentary, or complete Life Group itinerary, but simply as a conversational resource for further study. Feel free to use these thoughts below as you enjoy your Life Group experience or personal time with the Lord.

Focus: When someone is being intentional, what does that mean? What example come to mind of people being intentional. Finish the sentence, "To be intentional is to..." (make a list)

In the Bible book of Joshua, Joshua is about to die and challenges the people to be intentional with God. Read Joshua 24:14-15. How does this challenge further define the meaning of intentionality?

Reflect: Read John 13:1-17 and think back over Sunday's sermon.

What points of the sermon or this passage resonated with you?

What questions came to mind? How were you challenged?

How would you answer the question posed, How will we intentionally follow Jesus this week?

Dig Deeper: Being intentional takes grit and diligence. The Bible has a lot to say about diligence. Read Proverbs 13:4, 12:24, 21:5. The word diligence in these verses means to sharpen, to make decisions, to hunt after, to be intentional. So what do these verses saying about intentionality?

Read Proverbs 6:6-11 giving us an example of diligence/intentionality from nature. What can we learn about intentionality from the ant?

The Bible also challenges us to be intentional with other look up the following verse and discuss how to be diligent/ intentional with others: Ephesians 4:32, 1 Thessalonians 4:18, James 5:16, 1 Corinthians 12:2, 1 Thessalonians 5:11, Ephesians 4:32

Application: What is one or two things you could do this week to intentionally follow Jesus?
